ABOUT THE ACADEMY

The purpose of the TABPHE Mentoring and Leadership Academy is to seek out and prepare future leaders for major administrative roles in higher educational institutions.

The program will include a maximum of 15 participants in a three-day session. Upon completion of the Academy, each participant will be paired with a mentor who is acceptable to the participant.

Participants are required to attend all sessions of the Academy in order to receive a TABPHE Certificate of Leadership.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Faculty and mid-level administrators, directors, coordinators, and professional and technical employees who aspire to higher level positions in higher education.

Selection will be by competitive application. Institutions are encouraged to nominate employees for the Academy; however, members may self-nominate.

All participants must hold a master's degree or higher with experience in higher education.

Participants are required to attend all sessions of the Academy.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Letter of Nomination from participant's immediate or higher level supervisor
- Minimum of five years in higher education
- Demonstrated leadership ability
- Attached resume
- Statement on "Benefits I Expect to Gain from Attending the Academy"
- Signed commitment to attend the entire Academy

TUITION

Tuition for the full program is \$435 per person, inclusive of lodging, meals and course materials.
